This VIP contains **only** the survey responses for the State Assembly, State Senate and/or U.S. Congressional candidate(s) **that will be on your ballot**. ★ ★ ★ **Using the VIP** ★ ★ ★

The 6-digit code directly above your address on the mailing label indicates your State Assembly District (AD), State Senate District (SD) and U.S. Congressional District (CD), in that order (example: 05_02_08). Match your last two numbers with the CD number on the Congressional survey, if there are candidates from more than one Congressional District on this VIP.

Candidates' positions on survey statements are indicated as **S = Support, O = Oppose, U = Undecided, blank = no response**.

Candidates' party affiliations are as follows: **C = Constitution, D = Democratic, WG = Wisconsin Green, I = Independent, L = Libertarian, R = Republican**.

A cross (†) next to a candidate's name indicates the **incumbent**. An asterisk (*) in the responses indicates a qualified answer. **Qualified answers are posted online at YourWisconsinVote.org, or you can call WFC at 888-378-7395**. Contact information for candidates who did not return the survey is included. **We encourage you to contact them directly for their responses**.

8. Repeal the Wisconsin statute that criminalizes abortion.			
9. Require that persons voting in Wisconsin present some form of photo identification.			
10. Ban human embryonic stem-cell research and all forms of human cloning.			
11. Reform current divorce statutes to require mutual consent for couples with minor children in the absence of abuse, abandonment or adultery.			
12. Implement a universal state health care plan.
